The *Dyslexia Handbook, 2021 Update: Procedures Concerning Dyslexia and Related Disorders* is the primary source of dyslexia school law in Texas and contains guidelines for dyslexia and related disorders including screening, evaluation, identification, and instruction. Chapters 1-5 have also been adopted as a Figure in the Texas Administrative Code.

Dyslexia Handbook, Laws, & Rules - 2021-2022 UPDATES

September 2021, the State Board of Education voted to approve updates to chapters 1-5 of the *Dyslexia Handbook*, and the 2021 Update is effective as of February 10, 2022.
